
On November 10, 2016, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") suspending Respondent's professional nursing license for an indefinite period. Respondent has been granted a stay of suspension and her license is currently limited with certain terms and conditions.

On March 8, 2019, the Board Monitoring Liaison considered Respondent's request for a reduction in the frequency of drug and alcohol screens. Based upon the information of record, the Board Monitoring Liaison finds and makes the following:

ORDER

1. Respondent's request for a reduction in drug and alcohol screens is hereby GRANTED. Respondent's frequency is reduced to not less than 28 urine screens per year and one annual hair test.
2. All other terms and conditions of the Order not otherwise modified remain in full force and effect.
3. This order is effective the date of its signing.
