On May 30, 2017, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") limiting Respondent's professional nursing license with certain terms and conditions, including participation in a drug monitoring program.

The Board designee has considered Respondent's request for a temporary reduction in the frequency of drug and alcohol screens. Based upon the information of record, the following is entered:

ORDER

1. Respondent's request for a temporary reduction in drug screens is hereby GRANTED. Respondent's frequency is reduced to not less than 24 per year until Respondent gains nursing employment, at which time the frequency will be increased to not less than 49 per year.

2. All other terms and conditions of the Order not otherwise modified remain in full force and effect.

3. This order is effective the date of its signing.
