On January 10, 2018, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing ("Board") issued an Order Granting Limited License ("Order"), which granted Applicant a limited professional nursing license with certain terms and conditions.

On January 10, 2019, the Board considered Respondent's request for access to controlled substances, a reduction in the frequency of drug and alcohol screens and termination of the drug and alcohol treatment requirement. Based upon the information of record, the Board finds and makes the following:

ORDER

1. Applicant's request for access to controlled substances is hereby GRANTED.
2. Applicant's request for a reduction in drug and alcohol screens is hereby GRANTED. Applicant's frequency is reduced to not less than 14 urine screens per year and one annual hair test.
3. Applicant's request for termination of the drug and alcohol treatment requirement is hereby GRANTED.
4. All other terms and conditions of the Order not otherwise modified remain in full force and effect.
5. This order is effective the date of its signing.
