ORDER

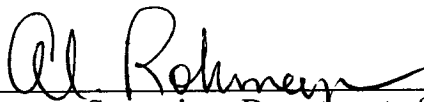

Under Wis. Stat. § 440.22(3), the Department may not restore, renew or otherwise issue any credential to Respondent until Respondent has made payment to the Department in the full amount assessed.
