
On May 2, 2018, the Wisconsin Real Estate Examining Board ("Board") issued an Order Granting Limited License ("Order"), which granted Applicant a limited real estate salesperson license with certain terms and conditions. On June 3, 2019, Applicant's real estate salesperson license was suspended for violation of the terms of the Order.

Based upon the information of record, including Applicant's petition for termination of the suspension which has been reviewed by the Board's designee, the following is entered:
