On June 11, 2018, the Department of Safety and Professional Services (Department) issued its Final Decision and Order in the above-captioned matter by which the Department ordered that pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 440.22, the costs of this proceeding be assessed against Respondent. The Department received the Affidavits of Costs from the Division of Legal Services and Compliance and Division of Hearings and Appeals. The Department considered the Affidavits of Costs on January 22, 2019, and orders as follows:

ORDER

Pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 440.22, the costs of this proceeding in the amount of \$1,410.25 are assessed against Respondent and shall be payable by Respondent to the Department of Safety and Professional Services (Department) should Respondent ever apply for any credential with the Department in the future. Under Wis. Stat. § 440.22(3), the Department may not restore, renew or otherwise issue any credential to Respondent until Respondent has made payment to the Department in the full amount assessed.
