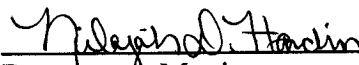
On June 19, 2018, the Wisconsin Real Estate Appraisers Board ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") suspending Respondent's certified residential appraiser license for fifteen (15) calendar days beginning ten (10) days from the date of the Order. Respondent's certified residential appraiser license was also limited, requiring Respondent to complete either 60 hours of education consisting of Comparison and Income Approach (30 hours) and Basic Appraisal Procedures (30 Hours), or pass the national licensing exam for certified residential appraisers, pursuant to the terms of the Order.

Respondent has submitted proof that he successfully completed the required education and as a result the following is entered:

ORDER

1. Respondent's certified residential appraiser license is returned to full, unrestricted status.
2. All limitations and encumbrances upon Respondent's credential are removed.
3. This order is effective the date of its signing.
