On September 5, 2018, the Wisconsin Dentistry Examining Board issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") requiring Respondent to complete sixteen (16) hours of education in "recognizing, diagnosing, treating and preventing oral infections", within 90 days from the date of the Order. On January 9, 2019, the Board issued an Order Fixing Costs requiring you to pay \$2,080.87.


The information of record demonstrates that Respondent has failed to pay the costs of the proceeding and to complete the education requirements. Therefore, the following is entered:
