

On September 26, 2018, the Wisconsin Architect Section of the Wisconsin Examining Board of Architects, Landscape Architects, Professional Engineers, Designers and Professional Land Surveyors ("Section") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") requiring Respondent to pay \$176.00 in costs of the proceeding within 90 days. The information of record demonstrates that Respondent has failed to pay the costs of the proceeding as ordered and, as a result, the following is entered:
