On September 26, 2018, the Architect Section of the Wisconsin Examining Board of Architects, Landscape Architects, Professional Engineers, Designers and Professional Land Surveyors ("Section") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") limiting Respondent's architect registration. Respondent was required to complete nineteen (19) hours of education, eleven (11) of which must be on HSW topics pursuant to terms of the Order.

The information of record demonstrates that Respondent has failed to pay the costs of the proceeding and to complete the education requirements. Therefore, the following is entered:

ORDER

1. Respondent's architect registration in the state of Wisconsin (#4402-5) is hereby SUSPENDED.
2. The suspension shall remain in effect until Respondent has paid the costs of the proceeding in full and has demonstrated successful completion of the education requirements of the Order.
3. This order is effective the date of its signing.
