
On November 13, 2018, the Wisconsin Real Estate Appraisers Board issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") requiring Respondent to pay \$628.00 in costs of the proceeding within 90 days. On July 2, 2019, Respondent's certified residential appraiser license was suspended for failure to pay the costs of the proceeding as ordered.
