

On November 27, 2018, the Wisconsin Funeral Directors Examining Board issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") requiring Respondent Frazier to complete six (6) hours of education on "professional conduct and business ethics" within 60 days. The information of record demonstrates that Respondent Frazier has failed to comply with the education requirements and as a result the following is entered:

ORDER

1. Respondent Frazier's funeral director license (#4898-77) is hereby SUSPENDED.
2. The suspension shall remain in effect until Respondent Frazier has demonstrated successful completion of the education requirements of the Order.
