ORDER


Pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 440.22, the costs of this proceeding in the amount of \$3,720.96 are assessed against Respondent and shall be payable by Respondent to the Department of Safety and Professional Services (Department). **Failure of Respondent to make payment on or before December 13, 2019, shall constitute a violation of the Order unless Respondent petitions for and the Board grants a different deadline.** Under Wis. Stat. § 440.22(3), the Department may not restore, renew or otherwise issue any credential to Respondent until Respondent has made payment to the Department in the full amount assessed.
