
On February 19, 2019, the Wisconsin Funeral Directors Examining Board ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") limiting Respondent's funeral director license. Respondent was required to complete fifteen hours of approved education in accordance with Wis. Admin. Code § FD 4.03 and shall include at least three hours as defined in each of the following subject areas: Wis. Admin. Code § FD 4.04(1)(a)1, Wis. Admin. Code § FD 4.04(1)(a)2, Wis. Admin. Code § FD 4.04(1)(a)3, and Wis. Admin. Code § FD 4.04(1)(a)4.

Respondent has submitted proof that he successfully completed the required education and as a result the following is entered:

1. Respondent's funeral director license (#4933-77) is returned to full, unrestricted status.
