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Please read this agreement prior to viewing the Decision:

- The Reports of Decisions is designed to contain copies of all orders issued by credentialing authorities within the Department of Safety and Professional Services from November, 1998 to the present. In addition, many but not all orders for the time period between 1977 and November, 1998 are posted. Not all orders issued by a credentialing authority constitute a formal disciplinary action.
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- There may be discrepancies between the online copies and the original document. Original documents should be consulted as the definitive representation of the order's content. Copies of original orders may be obtained by mailing requests to the Department of Safety and Professional Services, PO Box 8935, Madison, WI 53708-8935. The Department charges copying fees. *All requests must cite the case number, the date of the order, and respondent's name* as it appears on the order.
- Reported decisions may have an appeal pending, and discipline may be stayed during the appeal. Information about the current status of a credential issued by the Department of Safety and Professional Services is shown on the Department's Web Site under "License Lookup."

You are hereby notified that you are subject to a forfeiture of **\$250.00** in accordance with Wis. Stat. § 305.125(3)(b)1 for engaging in the business of installing, repairing, or maintaining electrical wiring without holding the proper license in violation of Wis. Admin. Code § SPS 305.41(1)(a) and Wis. Stat. § 101.862(1) at 4483 Chain O Lakes Road, Eagle River, WI 54521. This forfeiture must be paid within 30 days of the date of mailing of this Notice, or a 12% interest penalty will be assessed and/or enforcement action may be taken against you.

The forfeiture of **\$250.00** shall be made out to the "Department of Safety and Professional Services." Include in the memo line "17 UNL 162" and send to the following address:



You have the right to request a review of the assessment of forfeiture by sending a request to the Division Administrator, Division of Industry Services, P.O. Box 7302, Madison, Wisconsin 53707-7302, which must be received by the Division no later than 30 days from the date of mailing of this Notice. Any review of the assessment of forfeiture will be held in accordance with the requirements set forth in Wis. Admin. Code § SPS 305.125(6-8). In your request you must include a statement of the specific reasons why you believe the administrative forfeiture and the grounds for the assessment should be overturned. Wis. Admin. Code § SPS

305.125(6)(a)(3). Any issues not addressed in your statement shall be deemed waived for consideration by the Department at the hearing, and the Department shall only consider the reasons specified in your statement. Wis. Stat. § 101.02(6)(f).

You are receiving this forfeiture because you admitted to engaging in electrical work without a license at 4483 Chain O Lakes Road, Eagle River, WI 54521. This is a violation of Wis. Admin. Code § SPS 305.41(1)(a) which states that no entity may engage in the business of installing, repairing, or maintaining electrical wiring unless the entity holds a license or certification issued by the department. A fine of \$250.00 is entered is required by Wis. Admin. Code § 305.125(3)(b)1.
