
On March 14, 2019, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing (“Board”) issued a Final Decision and Order (“Order”) limiting Respondent’s professional nursing license. Respondent was required to complete four (4) hours of education on the topic of medication dispensing, five (5) hours of education on the topic of documentation and four (4) hours of education on the topic of ethics, pursuant to the terms of the Order.

Respondent has submitted proof that she successfully completed the required education and as a result, the following is entered:
