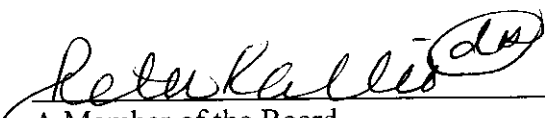
On May 9, 2019, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") limiting Respondent's professional nursing license with certain terms and conditions. Respondent was required to complete eight (8) hours of education on the topics of proper charting, pain assessments, and monitoring medication effects. Respondent was also required to complete an AODA assessment.

Respondent has submitted proof that he successfully completed the required education and assessment. Based upon the information of record, the following is entered:
