
On May 22, 2019, the Wisconsin Pharmacy Examining Board ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") limiting Respondent's pharmacist license. Respondent was required to complete four (4) hours of education for each of the following topics: pharmacy management, record keeping, and inventory concerning controlled substance pursuant to the terms of the Order.
