
On June 13, 2019, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") limiting Respondent's professional nursing license and her right to renew her practical nursing license. Respondent was required to complete eight (8) hours of education on the topic of ethics and patient care pursuant to the terms of the Order.

Respondent has submitted proof that she successfully completed the required education and as a result, the following is entered:

ORDER

1. Respondent's professional nursing license (#231563-30) and her right to renew her practical nursing license (#305708-31) are returned to full, unrestricted status.
2. All limitations and encumbrances upon Respondent's credentials are removed.
3. This order is effective the date of its signing.
