The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final disposition of this matter, subject to the approval of the Department of Safety and Professional Services (Department). The Department has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Department in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Respondent Jordan Newman (DOB 07/06/1995) is licensed by the State of Wisconsin as a Mixed Martial Arts Amateur Contestant, having license number 895-276, first issued on 07/27/2018 and current through 07/27/2019. Respondent's most recent address on file with the Department of Safety and Professional Services (Department) is 1207 West Carriage Street, Whitewater, Wisconsin 53190.

2. On July 28, 2018, Respondent Jordan Newman participated in the Pure Fighting Championships Mixed Martial Arts event in Milwaukee, Wisconsin.

3. Respondent delivered a blow to his opponent who fell to the floor, was concussed, and required immediate medical attention.

4. The referee had to physically restrain Respondent who lunged at his opponent, screamed obscenities, and appeared to spit at him after the bell rang.

5. Respondent apologized for his conduct which he attributed to taunting from his opponent prior to the competition but denies spitting on his opponent.

7. In resolution of this matter, Respondent consents to the entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Wisconsin Department of Safety and Professional Services has jurisdiction to act in this matter pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 444.02 and is authorized to enter into the attached Stipulation pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 227.44(5).

2. By the conduct described in the Findings of Fact, Respondent violated Fouls number 3 Association of Boxing Commissions and Combative Sports Unified Rules of Mixed Martial Arts (ABC) Rules as adopted in Wis. Admin. Code § SPS 192.45(12) as spittle flew at his opponent.

3. By the conduct described in the Findings of Fact, Respondent violated Fouls number 21 of the ABC Rules as adopted by using abusive language in the fighting area.

4. As a result of the above violation, Jordan Newman is subject to discipline pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 444.02(2).

<u>ORDER</u>

1. The attached Stipulation is accepted.

2. The Mixed Martial Arts Amateur Contestant license issued to Jordan Newman (number 895-276) is SUSPENDED for thirty (30) days after the date of this order.

3. Within ninety (90) days from the date of this Order, Jordan Newman shall pay COSTS of this matter in the amount of \$659.00.

4. Payment of costs shall be made payable to the Wisconsin Department of Safety and Professional Services and sent to the Department Monitor at the address below:

The Department may, in addition and/or in the alternative, refer any violation of this Order to the Division of Legal Services and Compliance for further investigation and action.

Respondent Jordan Newman and the Division of Legal Services and Compliance, Department of Safety and Professional Services stipulate as follows:

1. This Stipulation is entered into as a result of a pending investigation by the Division of Legal Services and Compliance. Respondent consents to the resolution of this investigation by Stipulation.

2. Respondent understands that by signing this Stipulation, Respondent voluntarily and knowingly waives the following rights:

- the right to a hearing on the allegations against Respondent, at which time the State has the burden of proving those allegations by a preponderance of the evidence;
- the right to confront and cross-examine the witnesses against Respondent;
- the right to call witnesses on Respondent's behalf and to compel their attendance by subpoena;
- the right to testify on Respondent's own behalf;
- the right to file objections to any proposed decision and to present briefs or oral arguments to the officials who are to render the final decision;
- the right to petition for rehearing; and
- all other applicable rights afforded to Respondent under the United States Constitution, the Wisconsin Constitution, the Wisconsin Statutes, the Wisconsin Administrative Code, and other provisions of state or federal law.

3. Respondent is aware of Respondent's right to seek legal representation and has been provided an opportunity to obtain legal counsel before signing this Stipulation.

4. Respondent agrees to the adoption of the attached Final Decision and Order by the Wisconsin Department of Safety and Professional Services (Department). The parties to the Stipulation consent to the entry of the attached Final Decision and Order without further notice, pleading, appearance or consent of the parties. Respondent waives all rights to any appeal of the Department's Order, if adopted in the form as attached.

5. If the terms of this Stipulation are not acceptable to the Department, the parties shall not be bound by the contents of this Stipulation, and the matter shall then be returned to the

Division of Legal Services and Compliance for further proceedings. In the event that the Stipulation is not accepted by the Department, the parties agree not to contend that the Department has been prejudiced or biased in any manner by the consideration of this attempted resolution.

6. The parties to this Stipulation agree that the attorney or other agent for the Division of Legal Services and Compliance may appear before the Department, without the presence of Respondent, for purposes of speaking in support of this agreement and answering questions that the Department may have in connection/with deliberations on the Stipulation.

7. Respondent is informed that should the Department adopt this Stipulation, the Department's Final Decision and Order is a public record and will be published in accordance with standard Department procedure.

8. The Division of Legal Services and Compliance joins Respondent in recommending that the Department adopt this Stipulation and issue the attached Final Decision and Order.
