
On August 21, 2019, the Wisconsin Medical Examining Board (“Board”) issued a Final Decision and Order (“Order”) limiting Respondent’s license to practice medicine and surgery. Respondent was required to complete twenty-four (24) hours of AMA or AOA Category 1 Continuing Education in subject matters relevant to medicine and surgery, pursuant to the terms of the Order.

Respondent has submitted proof that he successfully completed the required education and as a result, the following is entered:

ORDER

1. Respondent’s license to practice medicine and surgery (#20432-20) is returned to full, unrestricted status.
2. All limitations and encumbrances upon Respondent’s credential are removed.
3. This order is effective the date of its signing.
