
On August 22, 2019, the Wisconsin Real Estate Examining Board ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") limiting Respondent's real estate salesperson license. Respondent was required to complete eighteen (18) hours of C.E., in accordance with the requirements specified in Wis. Admin. Code § REEB 25.065 pursuant to the terms of the Order.
