NOTICE OF FORFEITURE

You are hereby notified that you are subject to a forfeiture of **\$250.00** in accordance with Wis. Stat. § 101.66 because you pulled a permit for the construction of a one- or 2- family dwelling with an expired dwelling contractor certificate. This forfeiture must be paid within 30 days of the date of mailing of this Notice, or a 12% interest penalty will be assessed and/or enforcement action may be taken against you.

The forfeiture of **\$250.00** shall be made out to the "Department of Safety and Professional Services." Include in the memo line "18 COM 11" and send to the following address:

You are receiving this forfeiture because you pulled a permit for construction of a one- or 2- family dwelling with an expired dwelling contractor certificate at N144W13765 Pioneer Road, Germantown, Wisconsin, 53022. An investigation was opened and it was determined you submitted for a permit on June 8, 2017, and listed your dwelling contractor certificate #5545¹. A certificate search found that the dwelling contractor certificate associated with this permit² was



expired from December 17, 2016 to January 29, 2018. Pulling a permit for the construction of a new one- or 2- family dwelling with an expired certificate is a violation of Wis. Admin. Code § SPS 305.31. Violating rules and statutes adopted by the Department carries with it a forfeiture of no less than \$25.00 nor more than \$500 for each violation as allowed by Wis. Stat. § 101.66 (See Wis. Stat. § 101.63 and Wis. Admin. Code § 305.12).

For these reasons the forfeiture of \$250.00 is assessed in accordance with Wis. Stat. § 101.66.
