On November 6, 2019, the Wisconsin Dentistry Examining Board ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") limiting Respondent's dentistry license. Respondent was required to complete Ten (10) hours of education in "root canals", and eight (8) hours in the topic of "the placement of crowns and/or prosthetics" pursuant to the terms of the Order.
