
On August 16, 2012, the Wisconsin Real Estate Examining Board ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") limiting Respondent Midthun's real estate broker license. Respondent Midthun was required to complete three (3) hours of education on the topic of real estate trust accounts pursuant to the terms of the Order.

Respondent Midthun has submitted proof that he successfully completed the required education and as a result the following is entered:

ORDER

1. Respondent Midthun's real estate broker license (#39448-90) is returned to full, unrestricted status.
2. All limitations and encumbrances upon Respondent Midthun's credential are removed.
3. This order is effective January 29, 2013.
