On July 11, 2013, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing (“Board”) issued a Final Decision and Order (“July 11, 2013 Order”) limiting Respondent’s practical nursing license (#34331-31) with certain terms and conditions. On May 23, 2019, the Board issued an Order suspending Respondent’s license pending the completion of a fitness-to-practice evaluation (“May 23, 2019 Order”).

On March 12, 2020, the Board reviewed Respondent’s fitness-to-practice evaluation report and considered Respondent’s request for termination of the suspension. Based upon the information of record, the Board finds and makes the following:

ORDER

1. Respondent’s request to terminate the suspension imposed pursuant to the May 23, 2019 Order is hereby GRANTED.
2. Respondent’s license is further LIMITED as follows:
  - a. Within 30 days from the date of this order, Respondent shall enter into and continue counseling with an addiction specialist (“Treater”) as recommended by the evaluator. Respondent shall provide a copy of all Orders to the Treater.
  - b. The frequency of sessions shall be determined by the Treater. Therapy shall continue until the Treater provides written confirmation that the treatment goals have been met.
  - c. The Treater shall submit formal written reports on a quarterly basis. These reports shall assess Respondent’s progress in treatment. It is Respondent’s responsibility to ensure the timely submissions of reports.
