On December 11, 2014, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") suspending Respondent's professional nursing license (#144193-30) for an indefinite period. Respondent has been granted a stay of suspension and his license is currently limited with certain terms and conditions.

On June 11, 2020, the Board considered Respondent's request for a reduction in the frequency of drug and alcohol screens and the frequency of reports. Based upon the information of record, the following is entered:

#### ORDER

- Respondent's request for a reduction in screens and reports is hereby GRANTED. Respondent's frequency of screens is reduced to not less than 14 per year and one (1) annual hair test. Respondent's frequency of work reports is reduced to once every six (6) months.
- All other terms and conditions of the Order not otherwise modified remain in full 2 force and effect.
