On January 14, 2016, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") suspending Respondent's professional nursing license (#198817-30) for an indefinite period. Respondent has been granted a stay of suspension and her license is currently limited with certain terms and conditions.

On December 10, 2020, the Board considered Respondent's request for a reduction in the frequency of drug and alcohol screens, and a reduction in the frequency of AA/NA meetings. Based upon the information of record, the following is entered:


ORDER
