
On August 4, 2016, the Wisconsin Cosmetology Board issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") requiring Respondents to pay a \$1,000.00 forfeiture pursuant to a payment plan. On August 19, 2019, Respondent's cosmetology license (#84598-82) and cosmetology establishment license (#39984-80) were suspended for failure to pay the forfeiture as ordered.

Based upon the information of record, which includes proof that Respondent has now paid the forfeiture in full, the following is entered:

ORDER

1. The suspension of Respondent's cosmetology license (#84598-82) and cosmetology establishment license (#39984-80) is terminated.
