On January 3, 2017, the Wisconsin Pharmacy Examining Board ("Board") issued an Order Granting Limited License ("Order") suspending Applicant's pharmacist license for an indefinite period. Applicant has been granted a stay of suspension and his license is currently limited with certain terms and conditions.

On December 17, 2019, the Board considered Applicant's request for a reduction in testing frequency, reduction in Alcoholics Anonymous and/or Narcotics Anonymous ("AA/NA") attendance frequency, and additional unsupervised practice hours. Based upon the information of record, the Board finds and makes the following:

ORDER

- 1. Applicant's request for a reduction in testing frequency is hereby GRANTED. Applicant's frequency is reduced to not less than fourteen (14) urine screens per year and one (1) annual hair test while Applicant is not working as a pharmacist. Upon providing proof of employment as a pharmacist, Applicant's frequency shall be increased to not less than twenty-four (24) urine screens per year and one (1) annual hair test.
- 2. Applicant's request for a reduction in AA/NA attendance frequency is hereby GRANTED. Applicant shall attend AA/NA meetings at a frequency of not less than once per week.
- 3. Applicant's request for additional unsupervised practice hours is hereby DENIED due to insufficient time in compliance with the Order.
- 4. All other terms and conditions of the Order not otherwise modified remain in full force and effect.
