On October 12, 2017, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing (“Board”) issued a Final Decision and Order (“Order”) suspending Respondent’s professional nursing license for eighteen (18) months from the date of the issuance of the Interim Order (July 13, 2017). On February 25, 2019, the Board issued an Order Granting Stay of Suspension and Imposing Additional Limitations (“February 25, 2019 Order”), granting Respondent a stay of suspension and further limiting her license with additional terms and conditions.

On February 13, 2020, the Board considered Respondent’s request for the ability to work in assisted living facilities. Based upon the information of record, the Board finds and makes the following:

ORDER

1. Respondent’s request for the ability to work in assisted living facilities is DENIED for insufficient time working as a nurse under the February 25, 2019 Order.
