On March 14, 2019, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing (“Board”) issued a Final Decision and Order (“Order”) suspending Respondent’s professional nursing license for an indefinite period. Respondent has been granted a stay of suspension and her license is currently limited with certain terms and conditions.

On August 13, 2020, the Board considered Respondent’s request for a reduction in frequency of screens and termination/modification of workplace settings. Based upon the information of record, the Board finds and makes the following:

ORDER

1. Respondent’s request for workplace setting modification is hereby GRANTED. Respondent can practice in a assisted living setting.
2. Respondent’s request for a reduction in frequency of screens is hereby DENIED.
3. All other terms and conditions of the Order not otherwise modified remain in full force and effect.
