
On May 9, 2019, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") limiting Respondent's professional nursing license (#144996-30) with certain terms and conditions. Pursuant to the Order, Respondent's license may be suspended, without hearing, upon receipt of information that Respondent is in violation of any provision of the Order.

Information has been received that demonstrates Respondent has ceased participation in an approved drug monitoring program and is therefore in violation of the terms of the Order. As a result, the following is entered:

ORDER

1. Respondent's professional nursing license (#144996-30) is hereby SUSPENDED until further notice.
2. This order is effective the date of its signing.
