
On September 18, 2019, the Wisconsin Medical Examining Board (“Board”) issued a Final Decision and Order (“Order”) limiting Respondent’s license to practice medicine and surgery. Respondent was required to complete two (2) hours of a Board approved course related to the Board’s Opioid Prescribing Guidelines, pursuant to the terms of the Order.

Respondent has submitted proof that he successfully completed the required education and as a result, the following is entered:

ORDER

1. Respondent’s license to practice medicine and surgery (#61479-20) is returned to full, unrestricted status.
2. All limitations and encumbrances upon Respondent’s credential are removed.
