On November 19, 2019, the Wisconsin Occupational Therapists Affiliated Credentialing Board ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") limiting Respondent's occupational therapist license. Respondent was required to complete four (4) hours of education on the topic of billing/documentation and four (4) hours of education on the topic of ethics pursuant to the terms of the Order.
