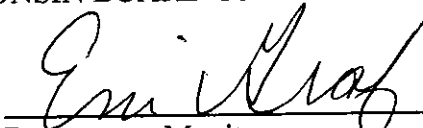
On December 12, 2019, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") limiting Respondent's professional nursing license and advanced practice nurse prescriber certification.
