The parties in these matters agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation entered into in the course of the investigations of these matters, subject to the approval of the Wisconsin Board of Nursing (Board). The Board has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Board in these matters adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following Findings of Fact, Conclusion of Law, and Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Respondent Bonnie S. Cabrera, R.N., (DOB August 30, 1984) is licensed by the state of Wisconsin as a registered nurse, having license number 233541-30, first issued on February 1, 2017, and current through February 28, 2020. Respondent's most recent address on

file with the Wisconsin Department of Safety and Professional Services (Department) is Post Office Box 145, Hatley, Wisconsin 54440.

2. At all times relevant to these proceedings, Licensee was employed as a registered nurse at various locations in and around Wausau, Wisconsin.

3. The Department's Division of Legal Services and Compliance (DLSC) has opened four investigations involving Respondent.

a. DLSC Case Nos. 18 NUR 160, 502 and 515 all involve allegations that Respondent diverted controlled substances for personal use while working as a nurse.

b. DLSC Case No. 19 NUR 038 involves Respondent's arrest for possessing and using methamphetamine while providing nursing care to a child at an elementary school.

4. Respondent is currently the defendant in three criminal matters pending in Marathon County Circuit Court: 19-CF-176; 19-CM-334; and 18-CF-1301. Respondent has been charged with felonies and misdemeanors in these matters for the conduct at issue in DLSC Case No. 19 NUR 038.

5. Respondent states she has not worked as a nurse since the November 2018 incident at issue in DLSC Case No. 19 NUR 038 and the above-noted criminal matters.

6. There has been no determination by the Board or a conviction by the Marathon County Circuit Court in any of the matters described above.

7. Respondent consents to entry of the following Conclusion of Law and Order.

CONCLUSION OF LAW

1. The Wisconsin Board of Nursing has jurisdiction to act in these matters pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 441.07, and is authorized to enter into the attached Stipulation pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 227.44(5).

ORDER

1. The attached Stipulation is accepted.

2. The license to practice professional nursing in the state of Wisconsin of Respondent Bonnie S. Cabrera, R.N (license number 233541-30) is hereby **SUSPENDED** during the pendency of these disciplinary matters: DLSC Case Nos. 18 NUR 160, 502 and 515, and DLSC Case No. 19 NUR 038.

3. The suspension shall continue until the Board issues a Final Decision and Order in the aforementioned disciplinary matters.

4. This Order is effective on the date of its signing.

STIPULATION FOR
INTERIM ORDER

Division of Legal Services and Compliance Case Nos. 18 NUR 160, 18 NUR 502, 18 NUR 515,
and 19 NUR 038

Respondent Bonnie S. Cabrera, R.N., and the Division of Legal Services and
Compliance, Department of Safety and Professional Services, stipulate as follows:

1. This Stipulation is entered into in the course of pending investigations by the
Division of Legal Services and Compliance.
2. Respondent is aware of Respondent's right to seek legal representation and has
been provided an opportunity to obtain legal counsel before signing this Stipulation.
3. Respondent neither admits nor denies the allegations in these matters but agrees to
the adoption of the attached Interim Order by the Wisconsin Board of Nursing (Board). The
parties to the Stipulation consent to the entry of the attached Interim Order without further
notice, pleading, appearance or consent of the parties. Respondent waives all rights to any
appeal of the Board's order, if adopted in the form as attached.
4. If the terms of this Stipulation are not acceptable to the Board, the parties shall not
be bound by the contents of this Stipulation, and the matters shall be returned to the Division of
Legal Services and Compliance for further proceedings. In the event this Stipulation is not
accepted by the Board, the parties agree not to contend that the Board has been prejudiced or
biased in any manner by the consideration of the attached Interim Order.
5. The parties to this Stipulation agree that the attorney or other agent for the
Division of Legal Services and Compliance and any member of the Board ever assigned as a
case advisor in these investigations may appear before the Board in open or closed session,
without the presence of Respondent or Respondent's attorney, if any, for purposes of speaking in
support of this agreement and answering questions that any member of the Board may have in
connection with the Board's deliberations on the Stipulation. Additionally, any such case
advisor may vote on whether the Board should accept this Stipulation and issue the attached
Interim Order.
6. Respondent is informed that should the Board adopt this Stipulation, the Board's
Interim Order is a public record and will be published in accordance with standard Department
procedure.


7. The Division of Legal Services and Compliance joins Respondent in recommending that the Board adopt this Stipulation and issue the attached Interim Order.
