On January 6, 2020, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing ("Board") issued an Order Granting Limited License ("Order") granting Applicant a professional nursing license (#251474-30) with certain terms and conditions including, but not limited to, no direct patient contact until Applicant has completed a fitness-to-practice evaluation by an approved mental health provider experienced in evaluating health care practitioners' fitness for duty, and the Board determines Applicant is safe to practice. The Order further states that Applicant's license can be limited in a manner to address any concerns the Board has with the conduct set out in the Order's Findings of Fact and to address any recommendations resulting from the evaluation.

On April 9, 2020, the Board reviewed and accepted the report resulting from Respondent's fitness-to-practice evaluation. Based on the evaluator's recommendations, the following is entered:

#### ORDER

- 1. The limitation for no direct patient contact is hereby removed.
- 2. Applicant's license is further limited to require counseling requirements as recommended in the Fitness-to-Practice evaluation.
- 3. All other terms and conditions of the Order not otherwise modified remain in full force and effect.
  - 4. This order is effective the date of its signing.
