
On February 13, 2020, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing issued an Order Granting Limited License ("Order"), which granted Applicant a limited professional nursing license (#252648-30) with certain terms and conditions. Pursuant to the Order, Applicant's license may be suspended, without further notice or hearing, in the event applicant violates any term of the Order.

Information has been received that demonstrates Applicant has failed to enroll in an approved drug and alcohol monitoring program and therefore is in violation of the terms of the Order. As a result, the following is entered:
