On February 13, 2020, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") suspending Respondent's professional nursing license (#130618-30) indefinitely and limiting it with certain terms and conditions. Respondent may petition the Board for an initial stay-of-suspension after demonstrating at least 30 days of compliance with sections C and D of the Order, and by providing proof that Respondent is fit to practice, including, but not limited to, completion of an assessment by an approved mental health provider experienced in evaluating health care practitioners' fitness for duty. The Order further states that Respondent's license can be further limited in a manner to address any concerns the Board has with the conduct set out in the Order's findings of fact and to address any recommendations resulting from the assessment.

On May 14, 2020, the Board reviewed Respondent's initial stay of suspension request and evaluation report. Based on the information of record, the following is entered:

ORDER

1. Respondent's request for an initial stay of suspension is denied pending completion of an evaluation of an addiction medicine physician as recommended in the fitness to practice evaluation. The Board determines this is necessary to demonstrate proof that Respondent is fit to practice pursuant to her fitness to practice evaluation.
2. This order is effective the date of its signing.
