On March 12, 2020, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") limiting Respondent's professional nursing license (#169507-30). Respondent was required to complete 3 hours of education on professional boundaries, 5 hours on documentation, 4 hours on professional accountability and 6 hours on opioid use and diversion pursuant to the terms of the Order.


Respondent has submitted proof that she successfully completed the required education and as a result the following is entered:
