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- There may be discrepancies between the online copies and the original document. Original documents should be consulted as the definitive representation of the order's content. Copies of original orders may be obtained by mailing requests to the Department of Safety and Professional Services, PO Box 8935, Madison, WI 53708-8935. The Department charges copying fees. *All requests must cite the case number, the date of the order, and respondent's name* as it appears on the order.
- Reported decisions may have an appeal pending, and discipline may be stayed during the appeal. Information about the current status of a credential issued by the Department of Safety and Professional Services is shown on the Department's Web Site under "License Lookup."

NOTICE OF FORFEITURE

You are hereby notified that you are subject to a forfeiture of **\$400.00** in accordance with Wis. Stat. § 101.66 because you engaged in constructing a one or two family dwelling with an expired dwelling contractor certificate. This forfeiture must be paid within 30 days of the date of mailing of this Notice, or a 12% interest penalty will be assessed and/or enforcement action may be taken against you.

The forfeiture of **\$400.00** shall be made out to the "Department of Safety and Professional Services." Include in the memo line "18 COM 157" and send to the following address:


You are receiving this forfeiture because you performed construction work at 6857 Mountain Road, Utica WI without possessing a valid dwelling contractor certificate and prior to receiving a building permit from the local municipality. An investigation was opened and it was determined that work was done at the site in the summer of 2018 and that you did not possess an

active dwelling contractor certificate at that time. A review of the Department's credentialing records shows that your dwelling contractor certificate was expired from April 1, 2018 to September 4, 2018. During that time you attempted to obtain a building permit for the work done on the site. Documents you provided indicate that you signed a building permit application on August 23, 2018. The permit was ultimately granted to you on September 12, 2018, after you had renewed your credential. Attempting to pull a permit without a proper credential and not being the homeowner is a violation of Wis. Stat. Sec. 101.654 and Wis. Admin. Code Sec. SPS 320.08 and 320.09.

Violating rules and statutes adopted by the Department carries with it a forfeiture of no less than \$25.00 nor more than \$500 for each violation as allowed by Wis. Stat. § 101.66.

For these reasons the forfeiture of \$400.00 is assessed in accordance with Wis. Stat. § 101.66.
