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

You are receiving this forfeiture because you performed HVAC work at 13901 W. Prospect Drive, New Berlin, WI 53151 without possessing a proper HVAC registration. An investigation was opened and it was determined work was done at the site in November 2018 and you did not possess a registration at that time. A review of the Department's credentialing records shows that Registration # 690738 for "Chiller Technologies Corp" expired on November 4, 2017. The identifying information for this credential finds that the address listed for Chiller is 934 N. Breens Bay Road, Oconomowoc, WI 53066 and a contact number of 414-313-2495. A search then found that Registration #1470086 for "Chiller Technologies" was approved on December 13, 2018. It lists the same address and phone number as Registration # 690738. The

Department has a preponderance of evidence that these two registrations are connected/related to the same business therefore you went over a year with an expired registration. Working on HVAC projects with an expired certificate is a violation of Wis. Stat. § 101.178 and Wis. Admin. Code § SPS 305.70. Violating rules and statutes adopted by the Department carries with it a forfeiture of no less than \$50.00 nor more than \$1,000 for each violation as allowed by Wis. Stat. § 101.66 (See Wis. Stat. § 101.178(5)).

For these reasons the forfeiture of \$250.00 is assessed in accordance with Wis. Stat. § 101.178.
