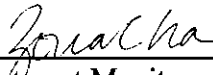
On June 11, 2020, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") limiting Respondent's professional nursing license (#226609-30). Respondent was required to complete four (4) hours of education on the topic of patient abuse, four (4) hours of education on the topic of ethics of nursing practice, and five (5) hours of education on the topic of scope of practice and execution of medication orders, pursuant to the terms of the Order.

Respondent has submitted proof that he successfully completed the required education and as a result, the following is entered:

1. Respondent's professional nursing license (#226609-30) is returned to full, unrestricted status.
2. All limitations and encumbrances upon Respondent's credential are removed.
