On July 9, 2020, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") suspending Respondent's professional nursing license (#138219-30) for an indefinite period. Pursuant to the Order, Respondent may petition for a stay of suspension upon providing proof, which is determined by the Board or its designee to be sufficient, that Respondent is in compliance with the provisions of Sections C and D of the Order.

Respondent's petition for an initial stay of suspension has been reviewed pursuant to the Order. Based upon the information of record, which demonstrates that Respondent qualifies for a stay of suspension at this time, the following is entered:

1. The suspension of Respondent's professional nursing license (#138219-30) is hereby STAYED.
