On July 15, 2020, the Wisconsin Medical Examining Board (“Board”) issued a Final Decision and Order (“Order”) limiting Respondent’s license to practice medicine and surgery. Respondent was required to complete three (3) credits of education in Legal Liability/Professional Accountability and three (3) credits of education in Ethics pursuant to the terms of the Order.
