On July 21, 2020, the Wisconsin Professional Counselor Section of the Marriage and Family Therapy, Professional Counseling, and Social Work Examining Board ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") limiting Respondent's license to practice professional counseling. Respondent was required to complete three (3) hours of education in legal issues and seven (7) hours of education in the practice of professional counseling, with four (4) of those hours in professional ethics and boundaries pursuant to the terms of the Order.


Respondent has submitted proof that she successfully completed the required education and as a result the following is entered:
