
On October 21, 2020, the Wisconsin Medical Examining Board (“Board”) issued a Final Decision and Order (“Order”) limiting Respondent’s medicine and surgery license. Respondent was required to complete four (4) hours of education in controlled substance prescribing and/or the Board’s Opioid Prescribing Guidelines pursuant to the terms of the Order.

Respondent has submitted proof that he successfully completed the required education and as a result the following is entered:

1. Respondent’s medicine and surgery license (No. 45288-20) is returned to full, unrestricted status.
