The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final disposition of this matter, subject to the approval of the Wisconsin Department of Safety and Professional Services (Department). The Department has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Department adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Respondent JC Public Safety, LLC is licensed in the State of Wisconsin as a Private Detective Agency, having license number 16943-62, first issued on October 25, 2012 and current through August 31, 2021. Respondent JC Public Safety, LLC's most recent address on file with the Department is located in Milwaukee, Wisconsin 53215.

2. Respondent Jose Carrasquillo (dob xx/xx/1964) is permitted in the State of Wisconsin as a Private Security Person, having permit number 46345-108, first issued on October 25, 2012 and current through August 31, 2020. Respondent Jose Carrasquillo's most recent address on file with the Department is located in Milwaukee, Wisconsin 53215.

3. Respondent Jose Carrasquillo is identified in Department records as the responsible licensee in charge of Respondent JC Public Safety, LLC.

4. On September 22, 2018, Respondents were performing security at a restaurant.

5. Respondents assigned three unpermitted individuals to perform security at the restaurant on the above date.

6. On September 25, 2018, the Department received a complaint regarding the security services performed by Respondents on September 22, 2018.

7. On September 25, 2018, the Department sent a letter to Respondents requesting a response to the complaint.

8. Respondents did not respond to the Department's letter.

9. In resolution of this matter, Respondents consent to the entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

#### CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Wisconsin Department of Safety and Professional Services has jurisdiction to act in this matter pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 440.26(6), and is authorized to enter into the attached Stipulation pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 227.44(5).

2. By the conduct described in the Findings of Fact, Respondent JC Public Safety, LLC violated Wis. Admin. Code § SPS 35.01(13) by assigning unpermitted persons to perform security personnel duties.

3. By the conduct described in the Findings of Fact, Respondent Jose Carrasquillo violated Wis. Admin. Code § SPS 35.01(13) by assigning unpermitted persons to perform security personnel duties.

4. By the conduct described in the Findings of Fact, Respondent JC Public Safety, LLC violated Wis. Admin. Code § SPS 35.01(23) by failing to respond to the Department within 30 days.

5. By the conduct described in the Findings of Fact, Respondent Jose Carrasquillo violated Wis. Admin. Code § SPS 35.01(23) by failing to respond to the Department within 30 days.

6. As a result of the above violations, Respondent JC Public Safety, LLC and Respondent Jose Carrasquillo are subject to discipline pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 440.26(6)(a)4.

ORDER

1. The attached Stipulation is accepted.
2. Respondent JC Public Safety, LLC is REPRIMANDED.
3. Respondent Jose Carrasquillo is REPRIMANDED.
4. Within 90 days from the date of this Order, Respondent JC Public Safety, LLC and Respondent Jose Carrasquillo shall each pay one half of the COSTS of this matter in the amount of \$526.00 each.
5. Payment of costs shall be made payable to the Wisconsin Department of Safety and Professional Services and sent by Respondents to the Department Monitor at the address below:



In the event Respondents violate any term of this Order, Respondents' credentials (numbers 16943-62 and 46345-108), or Respondents' right to renew their credentials, may, in the discretion of the Department or its designee, be SUSPENDED, without further notice or hearing, until Respondents have complied with the terms of the Order. The Department may, in addition and/or in the alternative refer any violation of this Order to the Division of Legal Services and Compliance for further investigation and action.

7. This Order is effective on the date of its signing.

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STIPULATION

Division of Legal Services and Compliance Case No. 18 RAL 013

Respondents JC Public Safety, LLC and Jose Carrasquillo and the Division of Legal Services and Compliance, Department of Safety and Professional Services stipulate as follows:

1. This Stipulation is entered into as a result of a pending investigation by the Division of Legal Services and Compliance. Respondents consent to the resolution of this investigation by Stipulation.

2. Respondents understand that by signing this Stipulation, Respondents voluntarily and knowingly waive the following rights:

- the right to a hearing on the allegations against Respondents, at which time the State has the burden of proving those allegations by a preponderance of the evidence;
- the right to confront and cross-examine the witnesses against Respondents;
- the right to call witnesses on Respondents' behalf and to compel their attendance by subpoena;
- the right to testify on Respondents' own behalf;
- the right to file objections to any proposed decision and to present briefs or oral arguments to the officials who are to render the final decision;
- the right to petition for rehearing; and
- all other applicable rights afforded to Respondents under the United States Constitution, the Wisconsin Constitution, the Wisconsin Statutes, the Wisconsin Administrative Code, and other provisions of state or federal law.

3. Respondents are aware of Respondents' right to seek legal representation and have been provided an opportunity to obtain legal counsel before signing this Stipulation.


4. Respondents agree to the adoption of the attached Final Decision and Order by the Wisconsin Department of Safety and Professional Services (Department). The parties to the Stipulation consent to the entry of the attached Final Decision and Order without further notice, pleading, appearance or consent of the parties. Respondents waive all rights to any appeal of the Department's Order, if adopted in the form as attached.


5. If the terms of this Stipulation are not acceptable to the Department, the parties shall not be bound by the contents of this Stipulation, and the matter shall then be returned to the Division of Legal Services and Compliance for further proceedings. In the event that the Stipulation is not accepted by the Department, the parties agree not to contend that the Department has been prejudiced or biased in any manner by the consideration of this attempted resolution.



The parties to this Stipulation agree that the attorney or other agent for the Division of Legal Services and Compliance may appear before the Department, without the presence of Respondents, for purposes of speaking in support of this agreement and answering questions that the Department may have in connection with deliberations on the Stipulation.


7. Respondents are informed that should the Department adopt this Stipulation, the Department's Final Decision and Order is a public record and will be published in accordance with standard Department procedure.
