On April 9, 2020, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing issued a Final Decision and Order (“Order”) requiring Respondent to pay \$1,125.81 in costs of the proceeding within 120 days from the date of the Order, and complete five (5) hours of preapproved education on medication errors and four (4) hours of preapproved education on the topic of documentation both within ninety (90) days from the date of the Order. In addition, the Order requires Respondent to enroll and participate in a drug and alcohol monitoring program which is approved by the Department within thirty (30) calendar days from the date of this Order.

The information of record demonstrates that Respondent has failed to pay the costs of the proceeding, complete the education requirements, and enroll and participate in an Approved Program for drug and alcohol testing as required by the Order. Therefore, the following is entered:

ORDER

1. Respondent’s professional nursing license in the state of Wisconsin (#130971-30) is hereby SUSPENDED.
2. The suspension shall remain in effect until Respondent has paid the costs of the proceeding in full, demonstrated successful completion of the education requirements, and has enrolled in an Approved Program for drug and alcohol testing as required by the Order.
3. This order is effective the date of its signing.
